Sub: Spot admission for B Tech Food Science course 2018-19

Ref: Letter No.CEE/5500/2017/KEAM-2018/TA1 dtd 07/08/18 of the Commissioner for Entrance Examination

A Spot admission for filling the vacant seats as noted below in the B Tech Food Technology course for the academic year 2018-19 will be conducted at the University Headquarters, Panangad on **10.08.2018 at 10.30 a.m. Remaining seats if any, will also be filled through spot admission on 13.08.2018 at 10.30 a.m.**

1. N R I seats

No. of seats: 2 (Two).

Conditions:

- (i) Candidates should be Foreign / Person of Indian origin (PIO) / Overseas Indian citizens (OIC) / N R I.
- (ii) N R I candidates don't need to have appeared for the Entrance Examination for admission to B Tech courses conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala. Marks secured in the qualifying examinations or equivalent examination will be the criteria for admission for these candidates.
- (iii) N R I candidates has to remit additional application fee of Rs.5, 000/- over and above the normal application fee of Rs.1, 000/- (Rs.500/- in the case of S C / ST candidates).
- (iv) At the time of admission, in addition to the first semester fee of Rs 53,450/- the N R I candidates has to pay one time admission fee of US\$ 2,000/- (US\$ Two thousand only) or equivalent Indian rupees.

2. Other seats

No. of seats : General Merit-3, Ezhava-3, Muslim-1, Viswakarma and related communities-1, S C-1, Children of Fisherman-8.

Conditions:

- (i) Admission will be based on the KEAM rank.
- (ii) Candidates seeking admission under the Children of Fishermen quota should be son / daughter / brother / sister of fishermen registered under the Matsya Thozhilali Welfare Board and has to furnish a dependency and income certificate from the Village Officer in the prescribed format in Annexure XVI available in the KEAM prospectus 2018.
- (iii) Fee to be paid at the time of admission: Rs.53,450/- (For General Merit, Ezhava, Muslim and Viswakarma). Rs.15,250/- (For SC and COF).

Eligibility / selection criteria for admission:

Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Mathematics separately, and 50 % marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together are eligible for admission. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, the marks obtained in Computer Science shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry and Computer Science, the marks obtained in Biotechnology shall be considered. In case, the candidate has not studied Chemistry, Computer Science and Biotechnology, the marks obtained in Biology shall be considered. The marks as shown in the mark list of the Board of Examination obtained from the respective Higher Secondary Board shall be considered for academic eligibility.

DIRECTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR SPOT ADMISSION
TO B. TECH. - FOOD TECHNOLOGY

1. Candidates have to produce the following documents at the time of admission :

- A. Original S S L C, Plus 2 certificate and transfer and conduct certificate from the institute last attended.
- B. Community certificate in original from the concerned Tahsildar in the case of SC / ST candidates
- C. Non –Creamy layer Certificate in the prescribed format in original from the concerned Village Officer for community reservation claims in the case of SEBC / OEC candidates.
- D. Original certificates as proof in support of any claim for special reservations.
- E. Physical fitness certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure XVII(a) or XVII(b) of the KEAM Prospectus 2018.
- F. Copy of the first page of the bank account passbook of the student.
- G. Three passport size photographs
- H. Copy of the Adhar card
- I. In the case of Children of Fisherman Candidates seeking admission under the Children of Fishermen quota should be son / daughter / brother / sister of fishermen registered under the Matsya Thozhilali Welfare Board and has to furnish a dependency and income certificate from the Village Officer in the prescribed format in Annexure XVI available in the KEAM prospectus 2018 and Original pass book and copy of the pass book from Kerala Matsyathozhilali Kshemanidhi Board.
- J. Candidates data sheet from the Commissioner for Entrance Examination
- k. Original certificates in support of any claim for special reservations, viz, sports quota, Children of Ex-Servicemen/Defense personnel etc.

2. Candidates have to remit the prescribed fee (in cash only) for the first semester at the time of admission. Part payment shall not be allowed under any circumstances. Admission shall be forfeited if fee in full is not remitted at the time of admission and the next eligible candidate will be admitted.

3. In addition, Rs 500/- shall be remitted towards Parent Teachers Association.

4. The admitted students who are eligible for fee concession shall apply online through e-grantz within 45 days from the commencement of regular classes. Students shall approach **AKSHAYA Centres** for online submission of application.
