DIRECTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR ADMISSION TO PG COURSES 2019-20

1. Dates of admission: 06th, 07th & 10th June, 2019 at the University Headquarters, Panangad.
2. Candidates shall produce the following documents at the time of admission:
 - a. Original SSLC/CBSE/ICSE and Plus 2/VHSE certificates
 - b. Transfer and Conduct certificates from the institution last attended.
 - c. Original Degree Certificate and Marklists of all semesters /years.
 - d. Candidates, who have appeared for final semester examinations of their qualifying degree course, shall produce the marklists (in original) of all semesters issued so far by the concerned University. Such candidates shall only be admitted provisionally to the course. (It is mandatory that the candidates, once admitted, satisfy the requirements regarding eligibility for admission to the course prior to the commencement of first semester examinations at this University. The University holds the right to cancel the admission of those candidates who are found ineligible to pursue the course.)
 - e. The candidates belonging to **SC/ST and OEC** categories shall produce original **Community/Caste Certificate**.
 - f. **Socially and Economically Backward Community (SEBC)** category of candidates claiming reservation shall produce original **Non -creamy Layer Certificate** in the prescribed format.
 - g. Original certificates in support of any claim for special reservations, viz, Sports quota, Children of Ex-Servicemen/Defense personnel, Lakshadweep Islands etc.
 - h. Physically challenged candidates shall produce original medical certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon.
 - i. Candidates belonging to '**Children of Fishermen**' category shall produce original and copy of the registration card issued by the Kerala State Fishermen Welfare Fund Board.
 - j. The candidates shall open a savings bank account in their name in any of the nationalized banks, preferably State Bank of India, and produce a copy of the

first page of the bank account passbook at the University on the date of admission.

- k. Three passport size photographs.
- l. Migration certificate from the University last attended, in the case of other state candidates.

3. Candidates shall remit the prescribed fee (in cash and Debit card only) for the first semester as shown below. Part payment shall not be allowed under any circumstances. Admission shall be forfeited if fee in full is not remitted at the time of counseling and admission.
