**Assistant Professor- Fish Processing**

- i. Master of Fisheries Science (MFSc) in Fish Processing Technology/Post Harvest Technology/Fish Quality Assurance and Management/Fishery Microbiology with specialization in Post Harvest Microbiology
- ii. ICAR/UGC/CSIR NET Mandatory
- iv. Essential: Bachelor degree in Fisheries Science approved by ICAR.

**Other eligibility conditions as per UGC Regulations 2018:-**

1. The clearing of ICAR/UGC/CSIR NET is mandatory
2. The clearing of NET / SLET / SET will not be required for candidates possessing a PhD Degree as per UGC Regulations / ICAR Guidelines
3. At least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in the subjects specified for the posts in the Faculty of Fisheries Science.
4. Other criteria as per UGC Regulations 2018 would also be applicable.
5. The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of UGC Regulations 2018 for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the

selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

### **General instructions**

1. A relaxation of 5% marks shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
2. A relaxation of 5% marks for the Master's Degree shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. Candidates must enclose attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority.
4. Age limit for applying to the posts shall be as per University Grants Commission / Indian Council for Agriculture Research and norms existing or issued from time to time.
5. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. Where the number of applications received is large and/or where it will not be convenient or possible to interview all the candidates, the University at its discretion may restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualifications/experience prescribed in the advertisement.
6. The qualification prescribed shall be as on the last date for receipt of application.
7. No interim queries regarding interview/selection will be entertained.
8. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
9. Interested candidates should apply in duplicate (2 copies) in the prescribed format attached here under along with photocopies of all supporting documents. Both the copies shall be properly bound (in book form).
10. All applicants should submit self-assessment Academic Performance Indicator approved by

University, attached here under with all supporting documents. Without supporting documents, the claim is not accepted.
