- 3. Poster Making Competition: Showcasing creative ideas about protecting the environment through posters.




INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

NAVAL NCC RECRUITMENT 2023



The program was officially started by the CTO-KUFOS, Dr. Anoop K.K. Naval NCC (National Cadet Corps) recruitment in university is a program aimed at enrolling students into the naval wing of the NCC. This program focuses on building leadership, discipline, and a sense of service

among young people, with an emphasis on naval skills and maritime knowledge. Recruitment generally includes an initial orientation session where interested students are briefed on NCC activities, commitments, and opportunities. Candidates may go through a physical test, a basic medical examination, and an interview to assess their suitability for the Naval NCC. Once selected, cadets undergo regular drills, physical training, and special courses focused on naval skills, including swimming, seamanship, navigation, sailing, and survival at sea. Cadets also participate in camps, cultural programs, and community service. Naval NCC cadets benefit from skill development, leadership training, and certifications. Completing the NCC 'C' Certificate with a high grade opens additional career paths in the Indian Armed Forces, as well as direct entry for certain defense roles. NCC cadets also become eligible for a variety of NCC scholarships and allowances. Joining Naval NCC in college is a prestigious opportunity for students interested in serving the nation, developing personal discipline, and exploring naval careers.






EBSB KERALA 2023


NCC DAY



WORLD AIDS DAY




INDIAN NAVY DAY

NCC Parade: The cadets performed a ceremonial march-past, demonstrating precision, discipline, and dedication.




PULWAMA ATTACKS


WOMEN'S DAY
